Motion by Packer with support by Bitely to approve the bills as presented. Roll call vote - all yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Meade with support by Bitely to approve the resolution to hold a hearing on Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. to continue the Special Assessment District and set hearing to confirm roll and levy the assessment for the eradication or control of aquatic weeds and plants for Bankson Lake. Voice vote - all yes. Motion passed,

Motion by Meade with support by Bitely to allow the DNR to remove mute swans on all four lakes in the township. Voice vote - all yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Packer with support by Meade to allow the DNR to destroy the eggs and nests of mute swans on all four lakes in the township. Voice vote - all yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Meade with support by Packer to accept the contract from Automatic Door Service to install two automatic door operators for handicap access onto existing vestibule doors in an amount not to exceed \$3,689.00. Roll call vote - all yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Packer with support by Bitely to approve moving forward with the appeal on the Bankson Lake drain. Roll call vote - all yes. Motion passed.

The regular meeting was adjourned at 7:45 to go into closed session to discuss the Bankson Lake litigation.
